Kansas Risk Factor Definition

Any history of preeclampsia diagnosed by a physician as self-reported by client; or as reported or documented by a physician, or someone working under a physician's orders. Preeclampsia is defined as onset of hypertension during pregnancy, typically with proteinuria, and usually after 20 weeks gestation.

KWIC will auto-assign if “Yes” is marked for the KWIC Health Interview question “Have you had preeclampsia during any previous pregnancy?”
