Kansas Risk Factor Definition

Birth of infant, at the most recent delivery who has a congenital or birth defect linked to inappropriate nutritional intake, e.g., inadequate zinc, folic acid, excess vitamin A. The infant’s condition must be diagnosed by a physician as self-reported by client; or as reported or documented by a physician, or someone working under physician's orders.
