Kansas Risk Factor Definition

A breastfeeding woman who meets the income and residential eligibility requirements may be presumed to be at nutrition risk based on failure to meet Dietary Guidelines **after a thorough Nutrition Assessment has been conducted and no other risk factors are identified**. For this criterion, failure to meet Dietary Guidelines is defined as consuming fewer than the recommended number of servings from one or more of the basic food groups (grains, fruits, vegetables, milk products, and meat or beans) based on an individual’s estimated energy needs.
