Kansas Risk Factor Definition

A breastfeeding woman whose breastfed infant has been determined to be at priority 2 nutritional risk. Do not use if the woman has already been determined to be at priority 1 nutritional risk. Note: If the infant was certified first and the infant’s priority does not match, KWIC displays a warning. Then staff can assign the appropriate breastfeeding dyad risk factor to make the client with a lower priority equal to the other dyad member’s priority.
