Rules:

- Photos must be taken in the State of Kansas
- Photos should reflect Rural Kansas Healthcare, specifically, the "Power of Rural"
- Photos will only be accepted electronically as high-quality .jpg/jpeg files that are at least 300 DPI or 2400x3000 pixels at 72 DPI.
- Photographers may submit up to 3 photos
- Contest is open to all ages
- Name/rename your digital files to match the "Image Title" you give each entry.
- Photographs that have been digitally altered beyond standard optimization will be disqualified.
- Only photos without watermarks will be considered

- **A Material Release form must be completed by the photographer for each photo.**
- **Only entries with complete and accurate information on submission form will be considered eligible.**
 - **Forms must be saved as Lastname_Firstname2021NRHDPC.pdf (example: Earhart_Amelia2021NRHDPC.pdf).**
- **If a Photographer chooses to include people in her/his/their submission, s/he is responsible for obtaining the necessary releases from the individuals depicted and must be able to provide copies of those releases to upon request.**

- Submissions will be showcased on KDHE's Facebook and Instagram pages from 12:00 p.m. November 15, 2021 until 5:00 p.m. November 18, 2021.
- Voting will be open Nov 15-18, starting at 12:00 p.m. November 15th and ending at 4:00 p.m. November 18th. A link to the vote will be available on our website, on the KDHE Facebook page, and the KDHE Instagram page.
- 1st, 2nd, 3rd place winners, 1 honorable mention, and 1 Office of Primary & Rural Health Staff Pick will be announced via social media and Community Health Access Newsletter by 5 p.m. November 18th, 2021.
