

- Supervisor's portion:
 - **How do you supervise BFPCs who work from home?**
Ideas included frequent check-ins and visiting often; meeting on a scheduled day at the office; and checking the BFPC Contact report weekly.
 - **When do you "Remove from Program"?**
Nearly all reported that when the client stops breastfeeding the BFPC clicks the box, "Remove from Program" and there were no reasons mentioned to keep a non-BF mom on the BFPC program. There was some discussion about continuing to follow a mom who is no longer on the program by setting a Next Contact date on the BFPC Summary screen, so she shows up on the Next Contact report but she will not be in the BFPC caseload once she is not on WIC. It was also discussed how moms who have BF a year or longer likely won't need as much support/BFPC time. One clinic just finished cleaning up their BFPC caseload by removing those women no longer breastfeeding. The SA has one slide in the BFPC training module that says "When the client is no longer followed by the BFPC, click the box to remove them".
