STAFF QUALIFICATIONS

Program Director

- Each child care center shall have a Program Director who is employed full time. KAR 28-4-428(d)(1)
- The Program Director is responsible for implementing and supervising the program KAR 28-4-420(w)
- The Program Director may serve as a lead staff if the facility is licensed for fewer than 60 children. KAR 28-4-428(d)(2) Each facility licensed for more than 60 children shall employ a program director who has no other assigned responsibilities.
- A Program Director meets the qualifications as specified in KAR 28-4-429 for the licensed capacity of the facility.

Lead Staff Qualifications

Each unit must always maintain a qualified lead while the unit is in operation.

KAR 28-4-429(h) – Each unit shall have one staff person who is at least 18 years of age and who has a high school diploma or its equivalent. Units enrolling fewer than 13 children shall have a staff person who meets the training requirements specified in subsection (b) of this rule and regulation. Units enrolling 13 to 24 children shall have a staff person who meets the training requirements specified in subsection (c) of this rule and regulation. Units enrolling more than 24 school-age children shall have a staff person who meets the requirements specified in subsection (d) of this rule and regulation.

When the regulation speaks to facility size it also means unit size. For example, if the unit is licensed for up to 12 children, at least one staff person in that unit must meet one of the four options under K.A.R. 28-4-429(b). If the unit is licensed for up to 20 children, the staff person in that room must meet the qualifications outlined in K.A.R. 28-4-429(c).

- Preschool Unit (12 children or less)
 Lead staff must meet one of the following qualifications within KAR 28-4-429(b) four options
- Preschool Unit (13-24 children)
 Lead staff must meet one of the qualifications within KAR 28-4-429(c) three options
- Infant Toddler Unit

Lead staff must meet one of the following qualifications within KAR 28-4-440(n) – three options

School Age Unit

Lead staff must meet one of the following qualifications within KAR 28-4-441(b) – two options

Mixed Age Unit (Infants and other children under the age of 6)
 Lead staff qualifications will be determined by the youngest child present in the unit.

Please Note: All requirements must be met before being hired as a lead staff. All lead staff must be qualified under ONE of the above options BEFORE they are allowed to be solely responsible for a group of children.

Assistant Teacher Qualifications

Assistant Teachers - Refer to KAR 28-4-429(i) - Assistant teachers shall be 16 years of age.
