The proposed action is to modify and reissue the existing NPDES permit for a facility for a proposed maximum capacity of 6,800 head (2,720 animal units) of swine weighing more than 55 pounds, 10,000 head (1,000 animal units) of swine weighing less than 55 pounds for a maximum total of 16,800 head (3,720 animal units) of swine. An increase in head count, but no change in total animal units. A new Farrowing Barn and a Mortality Composting structure are proposed. Waste is collected in pits below the swine housing and conveyed to a multi-cell wastewater treatment and storage system that will be modified into a three-cell system. This facility has an approved Nutrient Management Plan on file with KDHE.

The proposed action is to modify and reissue the existing State permit for an existing facility expansion for a maximum capacity of 210 head (294 animal units) of mature dairy cattle, 28 head (28 animal units) of

cattle weighing more than 700 pounds, 37 head (18.5 animal units) of cattle weighing less than 700 pounds, 583 head (233.2 animal units) of swine weighing more than 55 pounds, and 151 head (15.1 animal units) of swine weighing 55 pounds or less for a total of 588.8 animal units. This represents an increase in the permitted animal units from the previous permit. This permit is also being modified to add two 35 feet by 72 feet swine hoop barns within the facility footprint.
