Course Objectives

The ATLS course is designed to teach a standardized approach to the care of the injured patient. The course utilizes didactic lectures and practical skill stations to effectively teach the principles of rapid, effective assessment and stabilization. Successful candidates will be awarded four-year certification. All courses are conducted according to the guidelines of the American College of Surgeons.

Educational Objectives

Upon completion of the course, the participant will be able to:

- Demonstrate understanding of concepts and principles of patient assessment and management.
- Perform skills necessary to diagnose and treat traumatic injuries.
- Establish management priorities in single & multiple traumas.
- Perform the initial assessment and management of trauma victims

****MANDATORY FOR REFRESHER COURSE****

A copy of your current ATLS® card must accompany your enrollment application. Without it, we cannot accept your application.

To enroll: complete the entire course enrollment form and coordinate payment time. Course material cannot be sent until both the registration fee and enrollment form have been received. Course materials will be sent out 30 days prior to the course, unless payment and the registration form are received after this date.

University of Kansas Hospital Trauma Services reserves the right to cancel the program due to insufficient enrollment. In this event, you will be notified, and your entire registration fee refunded.

Registration must be made 30 days prior to class date as space is limited.

****REFUNDS AND CANCELLATIONS****

There **MUST** be a 30-day notice of cancellation from the enrolled class. In the event of cancellation, attendance can be rescheduled **ONCE** to another course date. **No Refunds will be allowed past one rescheduled date.
