

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

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PUSH EQUIPMENT**

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It is necessary to estimate charges for the use of the KDHE direct push equipment as K.S.A. 65-3455 provides for ...“Responsibility for payment of clean-up costs; actions to recover costs”.

The usage of direct-push equipment by KDHE staff for investigative and/or remedial activities at sites where responsible parties are determined or known may require reimbursement by the identified responsible party as determined by KDHE. If cost recovery is to be assessed by KDHE for use of its direct-push equipment, the following guidelines will be used.

Rates for use of KDHE direct-push equipment are as follows:

1. Mobilization/Demobilization charge: \$ 3/mile with a minimum mobilization/demobilization charge of \$200. The current Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) highway mileage chart will be used to calculate mobilization/demobilization mileage.
2. Daily rate of \$ 1,500 per day of use, with a minimum charge of one day. Daily rate includes direct-push rig, operator(s), expendables and abandonment.
3. Staff time and rates are a separate cost calculated directly from timesheets.

NOTE: Charges above do NOT include analytical costs or use of any field analytical equipment.
