



How to Access Drinking Water Watch and the Public Water Supply Data Collector Through the Kansas Environmental Application Portal

The Kansas Environmental Application Portal (KEAP) is a website that offers access to a variety of web applications which KDHE makes available to the public. Two of these web applications are relevant to the public drinking water supply systems of Kansas: Drinking Water Watch and the Public Water Supply Data Collector. If you have a username and password for KEAP you can log in at the main KEAP site (<http://keap.kdhe.state.ks.us/>) by filling in your username and password on the right hand of the webpage and clicking “Log In.”

The left side of the page shows the different areas of KDHE that have made applications available to the public. You will only have access to the applications you previously requested for your account. Once you are logged in, you will be able to access the water-related web applications by clicking on the word “Water” on the left side of the screen towards the bottom. This will take you to another screen which will show you links to all the water-related applications you currently have access to. When you click on either “Public Water Supply Data Collector” or “Drinking Water Watch” on this screen, it will take you to another screen where you will log in again with your KEAP username and password.

If you have a KEAP username and password, but prefer not to use the main Kansas Environmental Application Portal to access your water-related web applications, you can log in to Drinking Water Watch (DWW) at http://165.201.142.59:8080/DWW/DWW_login.jsp or the Public Water Supply Data Collector (PWSDC) at <http://pwsdc.kdhe.state.ks.us/>. A public access, “no login” version of DWW, which offers less detailed information, can be accessed at <http://165.201.142.59:8080/DWW/KSindex.jsp>.
