- Discuss issues involving safety, risks, response, & much more

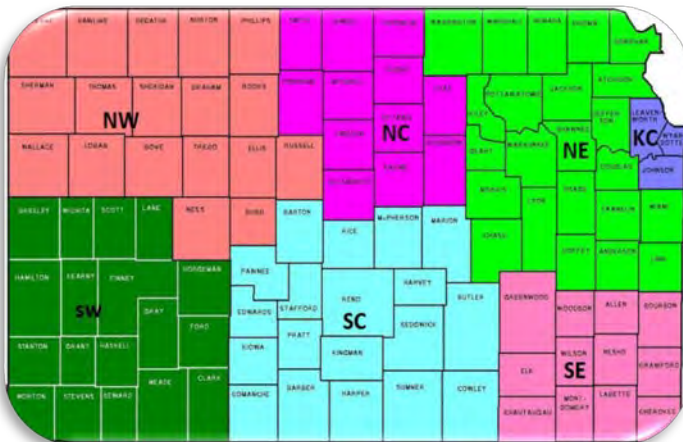
3 Cost Savings
