2008 – 22 additional
metabolic and genetic
disorders including
organic, fatty, and
amino acid disorders

2017 – Severe Combined
Immunodeficiencies
(SCID)

2018 – Critical Congenital
Heart Disease
(CCHD)

2020 – Spinal Muscular
Atrophy (SMA)

Looking Forward

Have approval to add 3
more conditions:

- Mucopolysaccharidosis I (MPS-I)
- Pompe
- X-Linked Adrenoleukodystrophy (X-ALD)
