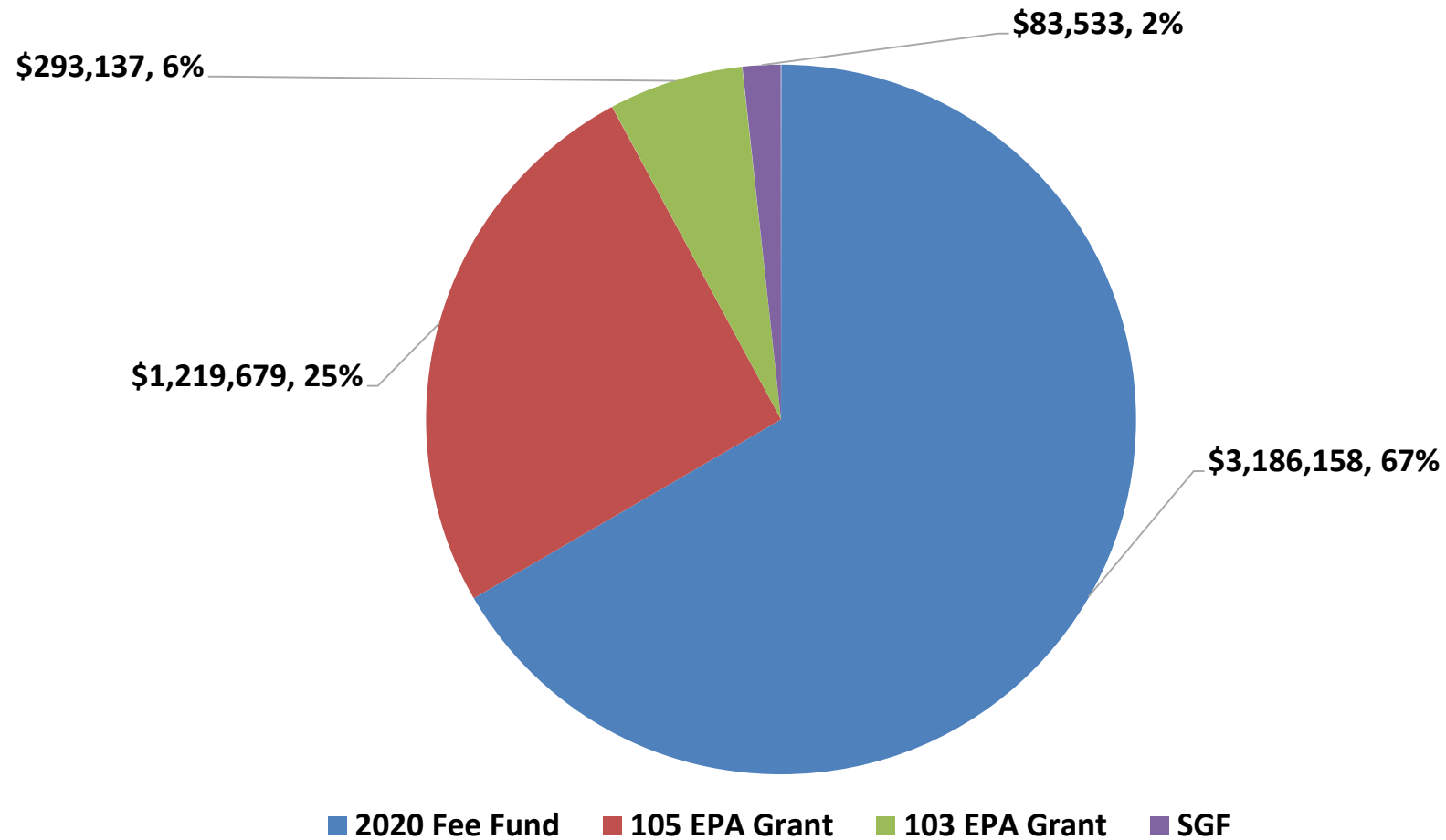

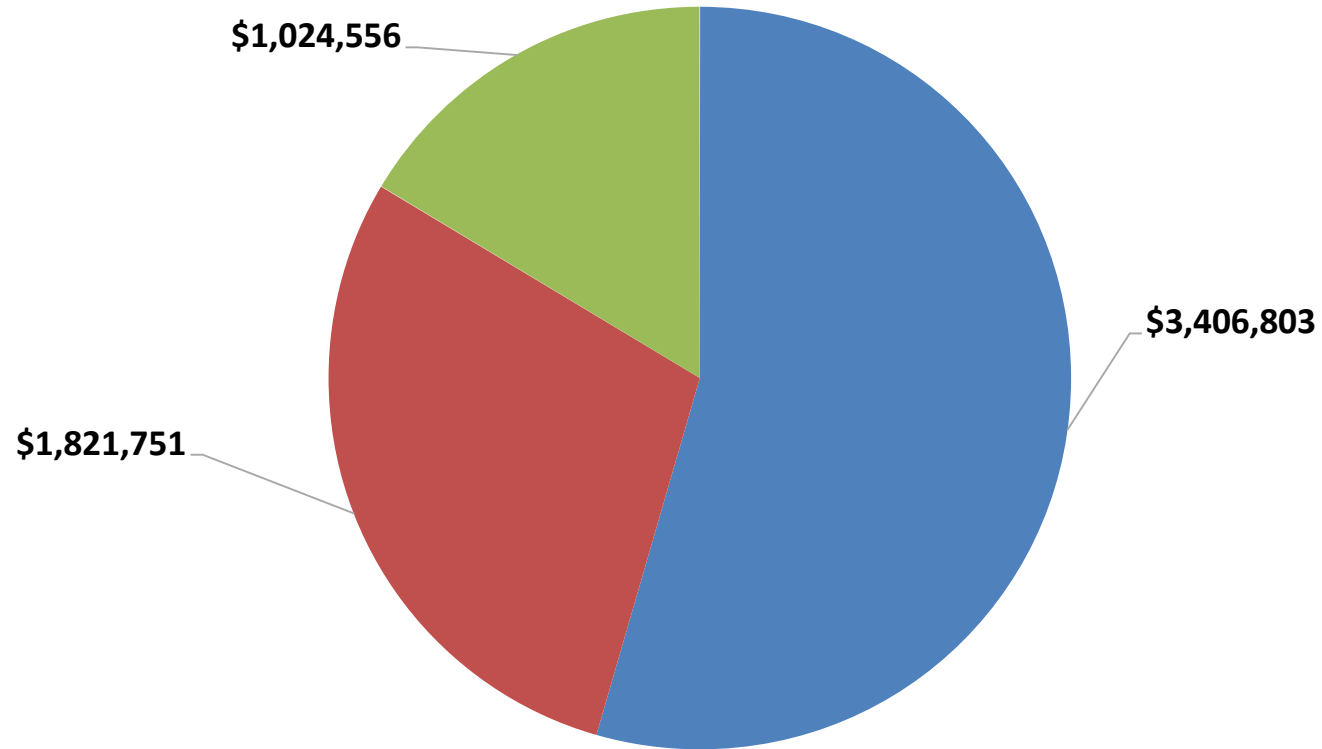

Bureau of Air Expenditures, 2017

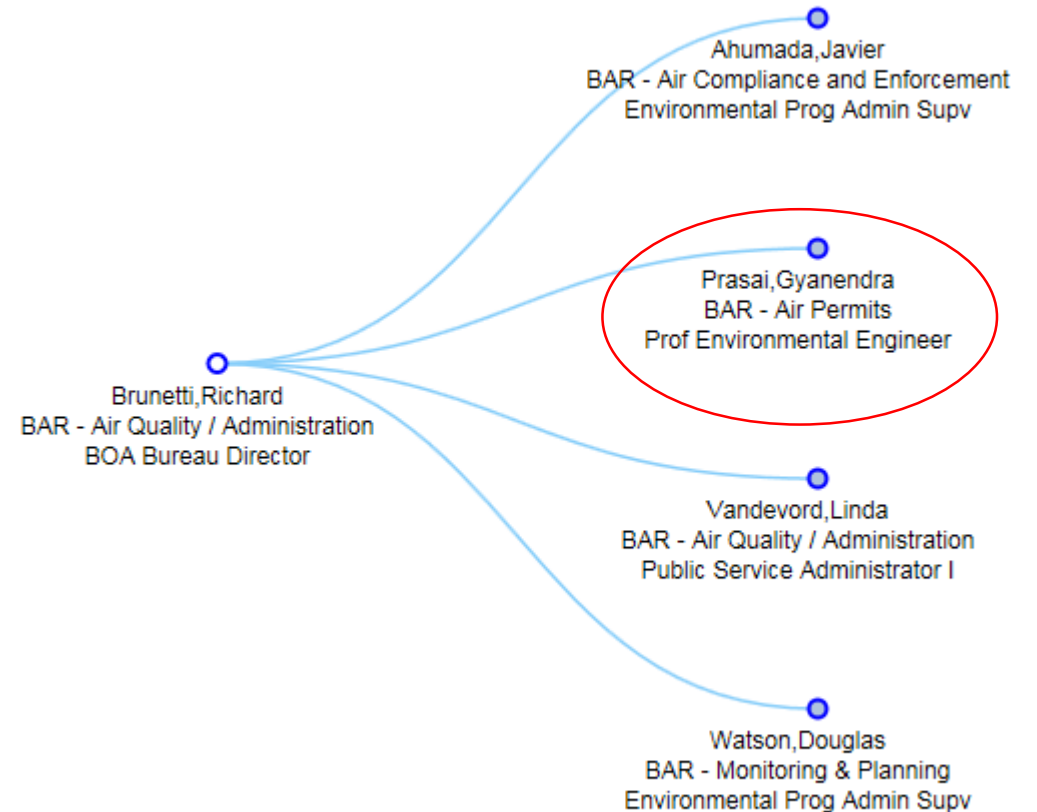

- Each Section Chief has Structured their Unit to Best Serve the Regulated Facilities



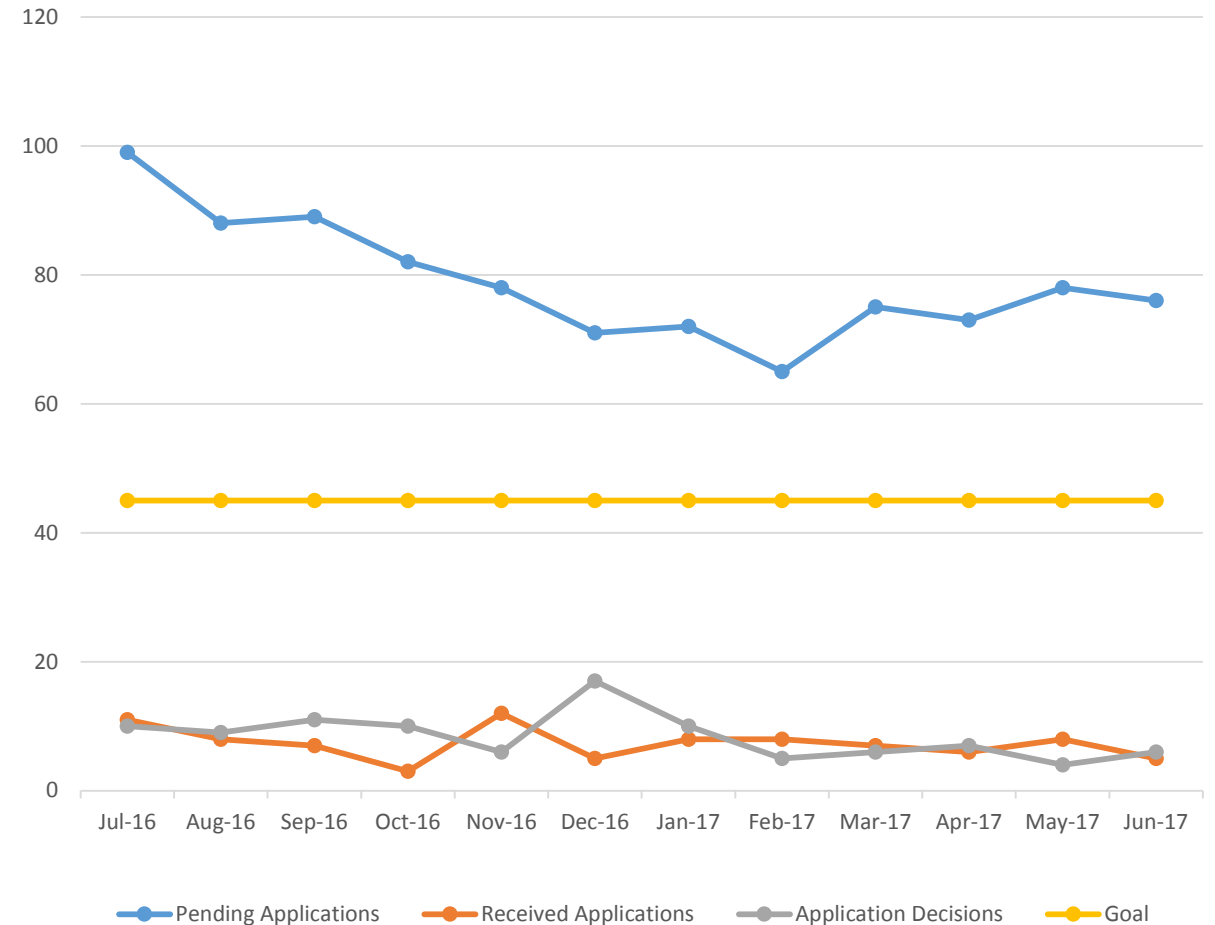
Flint Hills Fire Season

Volkswagen Settlement – Environmental Mitigation Trust

- States will receive funds for projects that reduce oxides of nitrogen (NOx)
- Bureau of Air in KDHE has been selected by the Governor to be lead Agency
- Allocation for Kansas is over \$15 million
- KDHE will be required to submit a plan for use of the allocation
- Ten eligible project categories established in the settlement may be considered in a state plan, ten year timeframe
